The Netherlands Authority for the Financial Markets ("AFM") is in receipt of the letter of November 5, 2007 by De Brauw Blackstone Westbroek together with the complete form H and all the other necessary documents.

Given your notification and the documents received, the AFM confirms that HarbourVest Global Private Equity Limited may commence marketing its units in the Netherlands.
